<u>Ithacare Center Service Company (DBA Longview an Ithacare Community) 2008</u> <u>Bond Refinance - Final Approval</u>

Martha Robertson moved to approve the Ithacare Center Service Company 2008 Bond Refinance. Rich John seconded the motion.
